Projects: main features

Implementation in 2 phases



Policy exchange of experience (1 to 3 years) ending with production of 1 **action plan** per region



Monitoring of action plan implementation (2 years) + possible **pilot actions**

Focus on Structural Funds

At least half of policy instruments addressed must be SF


1st and 2nd call – results





- 40 projects (out of 130) approved under R&I
- 340 partners from 28 Partner States
- 289 policy instruments addressed (ROP, RIS3)
- ERDF MEUR 59

21 projects focusing directly on RIS3



Industrial modernisation



16 project related to Industrial Modernisation

- 140 partners from 25 Partner States (81 NUTS2 regions)
- 108 policy instruments addressed (ROP, RIS3)
- ERDF MEUR 24

Technologies: nanotechnology, industrial biotechnology, advanced materials, photonics, advanced manufacturing.

Industries: Food, Textile, Chemical

Clusters: cross-cluster cooperation

Synergies with TSSP




Common points between IR-E projects and TSSP:

- Similar objective & target groups:
 - IR-E projects: preparation for strategic investment (*first stage of 'investment pipeline'?*)
 - Focus on regional development, policy makers and stakeholders
- TSSP can enrich projects scope and activities
- Possible pilot actions in projects: evidence of success for co-investment?


