

The services offered (free of charge) to PAAS users may involve the use of work stations connected to the Internet. For statistical and planning purposes (monitoring the number of users that, over time, make use of the service) and in compliance with agreements between the Ministry of the Interior and the Tuscany Region, with reference to Legislative Decree no. 144/2005 converted into Law no. 155/2005, access to work stations requires that identification be provided by users.

Children under the age of 15 may use work stations providing they are accompanied by a parent, who is required to provide identification.

Work stations may not be directly accessed unless identification is provided; if identification is not provided, users may access the Internet only through a PAAS staff member, subject to the duties the staff member is carrying out at the time of the request.

Users directly using work stations are personally liable for their actions and operations performed on the Internet. Use of work stations must at all times be consistent with the social promotion aims of the project "e-Toscana for access", within whose scope the PAAS network has been created.

Information Statement pursuant to article 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003

As part of the regional programme "e-Toscana for access" (initiative no. 2 for the creation of PAAS, Assisted Access Points to Services) the Tuscany Region and Municipality of, in partnership with local associations for the management of services, have opened the PAAS in which this Information Statement is displayed for the benefit of users.

Assisted Access Points to Services (PAAS), as part of their aim of providing a community service, and in accordance with the provisions of article 5 of Regional Law no. 1/2004, constitute a place in which *personal data are processed as part of the institutional functions performed by the Region and other regional bodies falling within the system of self-governing local bodies.*

In accordance with the provisions of article 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196 dated 30 June, 2003, we hereby inform you that:

1. in order to access PAAS services, an identity document must be provided; a photocopy will be made of your identity document and will be filed by the PAAS. if a photocopy cannot be made at the time the identification document is presented, the PAAS staff member may make a written copy of the personal details contained in the identity document on a special form, which will be filed;
2. the personal information provided by the identity document will be archived in a secure manner by the PAAS staff member; the information will only be disclosed, where necessary, exclusively to the relevant authorities;
3. statistical monitoring performed by PAAS staff members involves the recording of the date and commencement and finishing times of the user session at a work station; the statistical database managed by the Tuscany Region will record the information collected together with the user id number assigned by the PAAS; the information recorded is subject to the guarantees provided in point 2 above;
4. users will be liable for user sessions that are not compatible with the purposes of the local body/project or those set forth in Tuscan Regional Law no. 1/2004, pursuant to article 167 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003.
5. the data controllers for the personal information collected are the Tuscany Region and the Municipality in which the PAAS is located. The data managers are the Municipality and the association(s) involved in the management of the PAAS. The data processors are the PAAS staff members assigned to the task by the data managers.
6. you may exercise your data protection rights at any time with the data controllers, pursuant to article 7 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003.
