There is a long tradition in Florence, which began about 60 years ago

with the Course in "Economics of Tourism" founded by Prof. Alberto Bertolino (Dean of the Faculty of Economics), that went on with a first level degree and a second level degree. The experience Of the university of Florence

Recently (academic year 2010/11) there are still two degrees:

I level degree "Tourism studies" in Pistoia (*classe* L15) 180 ECTS-credits (three years)

II level degree "Design of tourist systems " in Florence (*classe* LM49) 120 ECTS-credits (two years)

The experience Of the university of Florence

In Italy there is a very strict regulation, due to the fact that there is a legal value of degrees.

For each *classe* we have different rules, fixed by the Ministry of Education, which bind (at least partially) the topics to be included in the curricula.

In the A.Y. 2010/11 we have **52** students enrolled for the first year,

while **42** students are enrolled for the second year, and only **17** students are out of the prescribed period.

Currently enrolled = **111** students In total ≥ **142** (**20** from outside Italy)

30 from the University of Florence (only 12 from the I level degree in Tourism)
